- Insufficient number of classrooms and ICT enabled halls to make the teaching and learning more attractive.
- The performance of the students of General course is not so pleasing.
- The number of enrolled students is decreasing.
- Too much burden for the teachers as they have to execute both academic and administrative works to encounter shortage of teaching and non teaching staff.
- Only a negligible no of General, MIL students are getting successful in their future job opportunities.

- After the corona period students are coming in the college in great numbers with the gradual rise of intake.

- The challenges





- To keep pace with the dynamic requirements of higher education.
