Begum Roqeya was a famous writer and a social worker. She lived in undivided Bengal in the early 20th century.

She born in a village called Pairabondh, situated in Rangpur in 1880. Her father Jahiruddin Muhammad Abu Ali Haider was an educated landlord.



She married at the age of 16, in 1896. She started her literary career in 1902 with a Bengali essay named 'PIPASA'


She died of heart problems on 9th December, 1932 in Bangladesh. 9th December is celebrated as Roqeya Day.

Statue of Begum Rokeya on the premises of Rokeya Hall, <u>University of Dhaka</u>






