





Begum Roqeya was a famous writer and a social worker. She lived in undivided Bengal in the early 20th century.



She believed that women should have the same rights and opportunities as men have in the society.




She born in a village called Pairabondh, situated in Rangpur in 1880. Her father Jahiruddin Muhammad Abu Ali Haider was an educated landlord.


Roqeya was married to Khan Bhadur Sakhawat Hussain in 1896. He was the Deputy Magistrate of Bhagalpur, now in Bihar. He encouraged Roqeya through his life.



Roqeya learnt Bangla and
English from her brother
Ibrahim.



She married at the age of
16, in 1896. She started her
literary career in 1902 with
a Bengali essay named
'PIPASA'



She died of heart problems
on 9th December, 1932 in
Bangladesh. 9th December
is celebrated as Roqeya
Day.

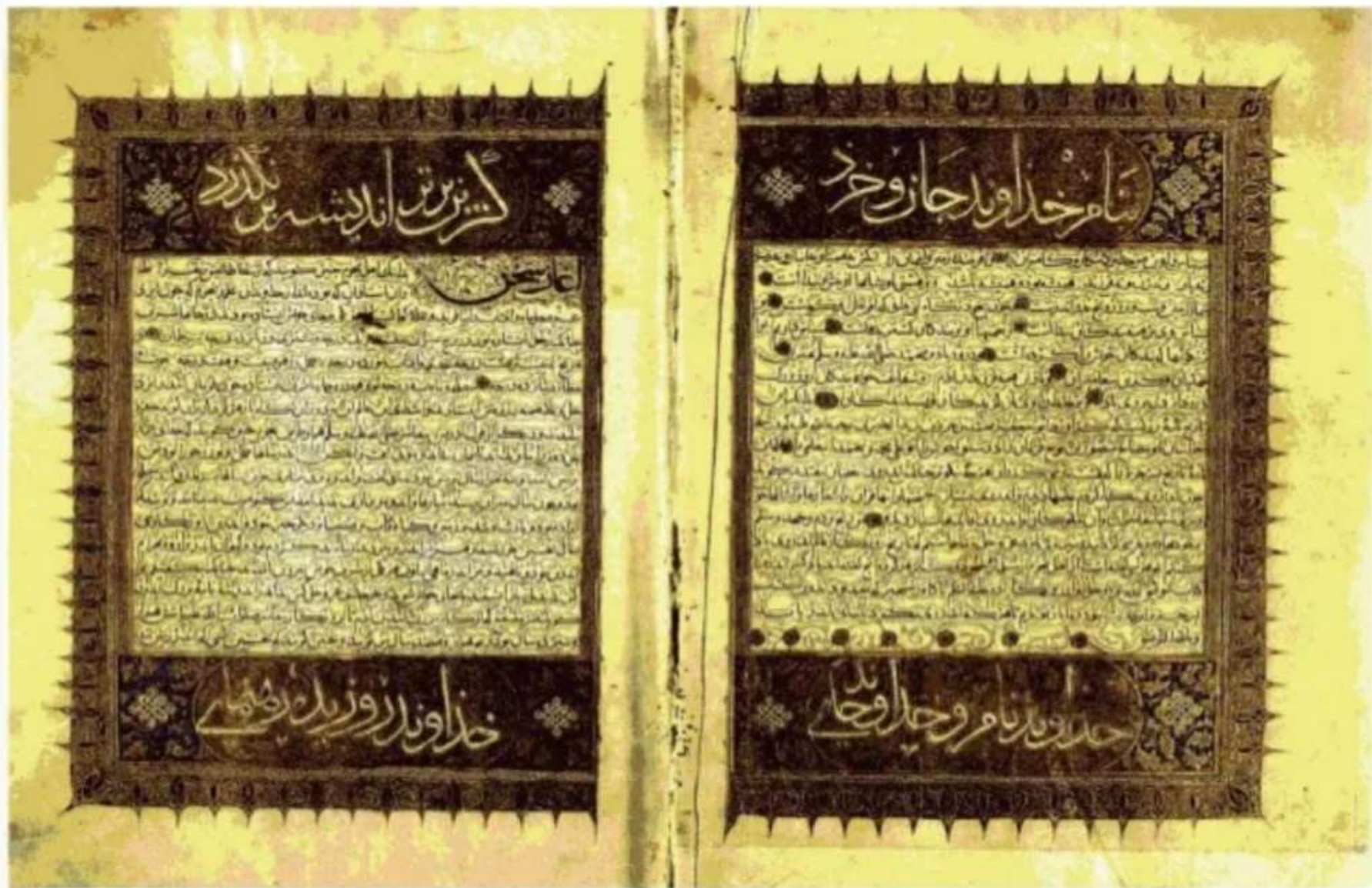

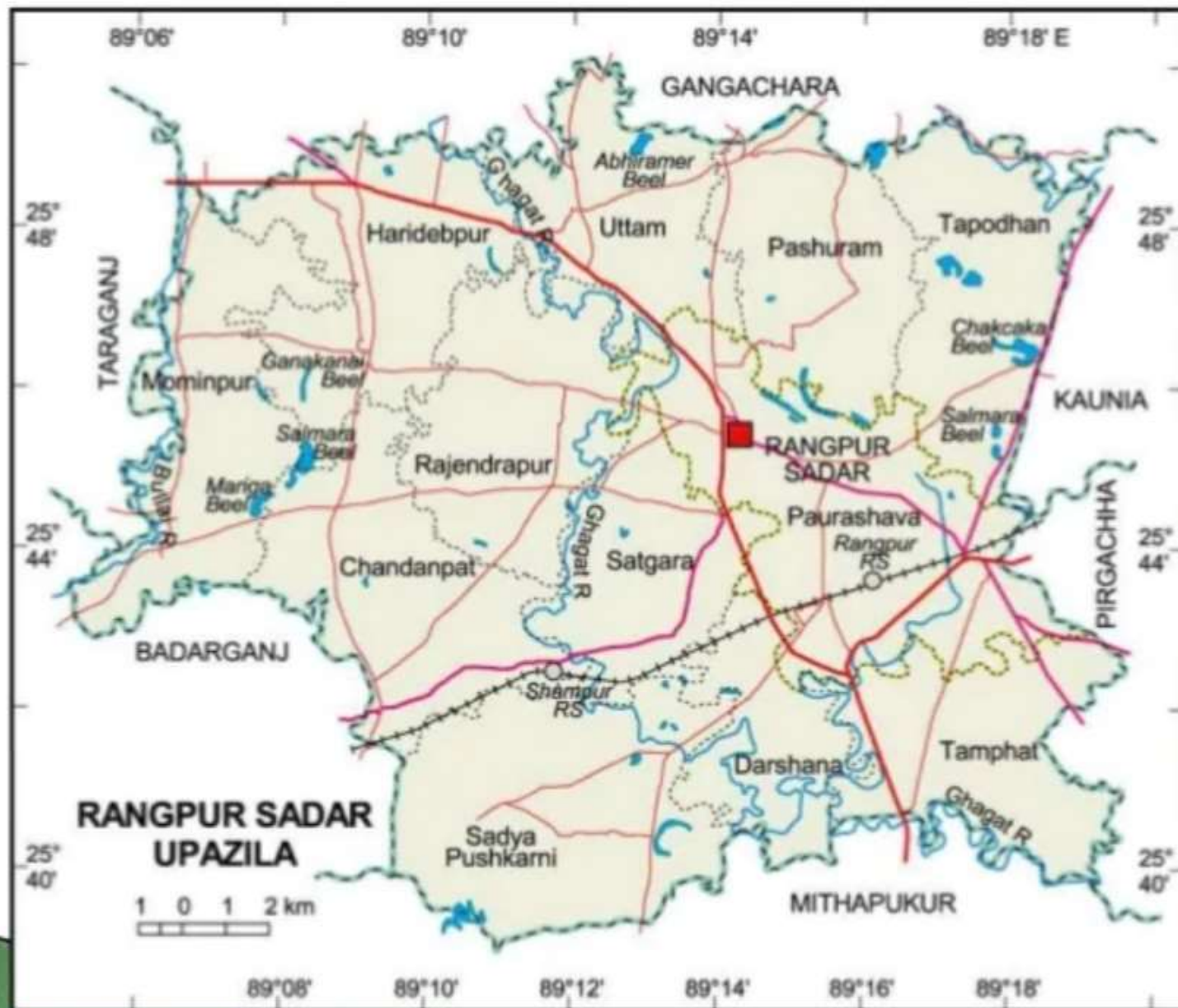
